The town has already approved highly industrial sites like the gas plant on Route 6 and the power station at the intersection of Route 6 and 17M. This area comprising Middletown/Wawayanda needs more green space, pedestrian amenities, and tree plantings going right up to the railroad crossing on Dolson and on James P. Kelly Way.
